

SADA Awards Criteria – Young Farmer of the Year

The South Australian Dairyfarmers' Association presents three awards at the annual DIAA Awards Gala, to recognize the contribution and effort of farmers over the past 12 months.

The prize recipient is determined by a SADA panel including the Dairy SA Young Dairy Network Coordinator.

The following criteria is considered for judging the "Young Dairy Farmer of the Year" award;

Criteria

- The nominee must be over the age of 16 years and under the age of 35 years on the day for which the entries for the awards close.
- The young farmer is judged on his/her management philosophy as well as technical abilities.
- The nominee may farm on his/her own or in a partnership with others. In the latter case, the nominee must have specific allocated responsibilities and decision-making authority on which he/she will be judged.
- The nominee will need to possess the skills to run a profitable and sustainable dairy business currently or in the near future.
- The nominee must not be a previous winner of this award.
